


Exploring Online Chapel

^{*}Internet where you could video conference or watch a movie :)


Today we'll reimagine with examples, considerations, and questions.


But first, let's open with a short prayer.

Let's break down some of those beloved chapel elements and brainstorm about them in an online setting.




Overall, look for places where you can "flip" your chapel using visuals, polls, chat, and tools. Think about your chapel in beats. Each beat needs at least one slide.





JESUS [cupping mouth for volume]: Throw out your net on the right-hand side of the boat, and you'll get some!"







³¹ So he went to her bedside, took her by the hand, and helped her sit up. Then the reverleft her, and she prepared a meal for them.


